IVCCI was set up in 1990 as a result of a MoU signed between the Indian Merchants' Chamber (IMC), Mumbai and Vietnam Chamber of Commerce & Industry (VCCI), Hanoi. The main objective of the IVCCI is to promote two-way trade and economic relations between India and Vietnam. In last 25 years of its existence, IVCCI has sponsored four business delegations to Vietnam and participated in Quang Trung International Trade Fair in Ho Chi Minh City.

The India - Vietnam Joint Business Council was established in 1992 and the Consulate General of Vietnam in Mumbai came into being in 1993 - an outcome of recommendations of IVCCI's business delegations, which visited Vietnam as early as in 1991 and 1992.

The IVCCI has been recognised by the Government of India and the Government of Vietnam as a nodal agency to promote trade and economic relations between India and Vietnam.
